

How To Get a Food Handler's Certificate in Nairobi

With Testing by Cerba Lancet Kenya

Are you working in the food industry or planning to start a food business? To handle or sell food in Nairobi, you are required to obtain a Food Handler's Certificate from the Nairobi County Government.

Nairobi County officially approves Cerba Lancet Kenya to conduct Food Handler medical tests at our select branches.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Register and Apply via the Nairobi City County Portal

- Visit: <https://nairobiservices.go.ke>
- Click on the "Create Account" button.
- Choose "Organization" and specify whether it's a local or foreign entity.
- Enter the organization's name, registration number, KRA PIN, and contact information.
- An OTP will be sent to the provided phone number. Enter this OTP to verify.
- Create a secure password and agree to the terms and conditions.
- Click "Create Account" to finalize the process.

Note: After successful registration, you'll receive a confirmation SMS.

2. Access your account at <https://nairobiservices.go.ke/login>

- On your dashboard, click on the "Services" tab.
- Under the "Health Services" section, choose "Food Handler" and then click on "Apply for Food Handler Certificate."
- Provide the required organization details as prompted.

3. Generate Payment

- The system will generate a bill for the application fee.
- Make Payment via M-Pesa or other available payment options. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the payment.
- After payment, you'll receive a notification with details about the required medical tests (stool and urine samples).

Visit Your Selected Cerba Lancet Kenya Branch:

- Upper Hill – 5th Avenue Suits
- Parklands – Park Place Offices
- Eastleigh – Daus Plaza

**Testing and sample collection are completed in under 1 hour*

4. Results & Certification

- We upload your test results directly to the Nairobi County portal
- The County Government issues the certificate once your results are approved
- The certificate is valid for 6 months
