Routine clinical pathology

Close to patients and within health centres, our network combines expertise and proximity with up to 1 000 clinical pathologists in our 1,160 laboratories in France, Luxembourg, Belgium, Italy and Africa, treating more than 45 millions patients every year.

Thanks to their geographical proximity and daily work with clinicians, our teams participate in the screening and initial diagnosis of "city" patients, in particular by carrying out routine biological tests, which are essential for the early detection of diseases. Although it is the fundamental mission of the local laboratory, this first-line work requires thoroughness, responsiveness, versatility, but also contribute to patients primary care.



Specialised clinical pathology

Cerba, at the origin of the creation of the Cerba HealthCare Group, is a world-class leader in specialised clinical pathology.

The laboratory performs complex analyses -on samples coming from 50 countries around the globe- on behalf of other clinical pathology laboratories that cannot perform their own analyses because of the level of expertise, equipment or certification required. Cerba offers an unrivalled panel of over 2,500 tests covering 40 medical specialties and performs 140 000 analyses each day for public and private health institutions around the world, ensuiring an essential link in the healthcare service offering.

Clinical pathology for clinical trials

Before any new drug can be authorised, it must undergo a rigorous process of clinical studies. In order to carry out a clinical trial, pharmaceutical companies need partners capable of handling patient recruitment, analyses, sample transport, results management and storage of biological samples (biobanking). Cerba Research provides this expertise that is key to pharmaceutical industry, biotechnology companies, CROs, specialists of IVD (in vitro diagnostics) and research institutions all together. Its offering covers early phase trials, clinical development as well as development and validation of testing and biomarkers.

Clinical pathology for clinical trials has become an indispensable tool for the implementation and acceleration of new therapies and also contributes to the production of fundamental knowledge in medicine and human biology.





Veterinary clinical pathology

Cerba Vet supports veterinarians with a comprehensive in vitro diagnostic offer comprising 3 complementary expertises : clinical pathology, anatomocytopathology and veterinary genetics. Cerba Vet also relies on dedicated technical platforms to ensure the security and traceability of samples and the control of time-to-results, as well as accredited logistics for territorial coverage throughout France



Anatomo-cythopathology

At the crossroads of clinical, surgical, imaging, medical pathology and research, anatomo-cytopathology plays a key role in the diagnosis, prognosis and treatment of diseases, in particular cancers. Often unknown to the general public, anatomo-cytopathologists develop and carry out the most innovative personalised medicine examinations every day and evaluate the therapeutic success of treatments recommended for cancer patients.

Cerba Path can count on a network of 40 physicians and 200 collaborators thoughout 5 technical platforms (France, Belgium). Our teams work primarily with surgeons, physicians from all disciplines and midwives.

Medical imaging

Medical imaging is increasingly used for the diagnosis of many diseases in addition to clinical examination and other investigations such as biological tests. Continued advances in imaging techniques allow earlier and more accurate detection of diseases, for more targeted, less invasive treatment and close monitoring of the therapeutic response.

At Cerba HealthCare, this activity is currently developed in Italy with 7 radiology centres in Lombardy, Campania and Piemont.
